NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 49 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT: MUNICIPAL PROPERTY RATES ACT, 2004 (Act No.6 OF 2004): PUBLIC NOTICE OF INSPECTION AND OBJECTION OF DIKGATLONG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY'S VALUATION ROLL EFFECTIVE FROM 1 JULY 2019.

The Municipality has undertaken a general valuation and prepared a certified valuation roll of all properties in its jurisdiction in terms of applicable legislation and policies. Notice is hereby issued in terms of Section 49 (1) (a) of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act, 2004 (Act No.6 of 2004), as amended, hereinafter referred to as the "Act", that the valuation roll for the period 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2025 is open for public inspection at the Municipal Offices, listed below, from 15 February 2019 to 31 March 2019. An invitation is hereby made in terms of section 49 (1)(a)(ii) of the Act that any owner of property or other person who so desires should lodge an objection with the Municipal Manager in respect of any matter reflected in, or omitted from, the valuation roll within the above-mentioned period.

Attention is specifically drawn to the fact that in terms of Section 50(2) of the Act, an objection must be in relation to a specific individual property and not against the General Valuation Roll as such.
