Dikgatlong Municipality hereby invites suitably prospective service providers to quote for **REPLACEMENT OF OLD POLES & INSTALLATION OF ABC NEAR BOTHA STREET** clearly endorsed" RFQ22/2025/26 **REPLACEMENT OF OLD POLES & INSTALLATION OF ABC NEAR BOTHA STREET "** on the envelope must be submitted **on the tender box** situated at the reception area of Dikgatlong Local Municipality, 33 Campbell Street, Barkly West, 8375.

Bids **must** reach the municipality before **12h00 on Wednesday the 18th of March 2026**.

PURPOSE, BACKGROUND AND SPECIFICATIONS/ SCOPE OF WORK

Purpose

The purpose of this RFQ is to get potential prospective service provider to replace all old and decayed poles and to install Aerial Bundled Conductor (ABC) on the affected power line. This will improve reliability and reduce power outages.

Background

A site inspection was done on the existing power line. It was found that most of the wooden poles are old, decayed and leaning to one side and the conductors are not properly aligned. During windy and rainy seasons, the conductor's phases clash with each other. This causes frequent power trips and outages in the area. The current situation is unsafe and increases maintenance work. There is also a risk that some poles may collapse if no action is taken. Installing ABC will reduce faults caused by conductor clashing during bad weather conditions. It will improve safety, reduce outages and ensure continuous power supply to the area.



Scope of Work

4.	Supply and installation of ABC straining clamps for bare Neutral conductor	9

1. Late, emailed, faxed, incomplete quotes will not be considered.

2. All quotes will be adjudicated and awarded in terms of the Dikgatlong Local Municipality Procurement and Supply Chain Management Policy, the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and the regulations promulgated under this Act. This bid is

subject to the General Conditions of Contract and, if applicable, any other Special Condition of Contract.

3. Quotes must be valid for a period of 30 days

4. Suppliers must submit their quotes with the following documentation and or information:

4.1 A valid original Tax Clearance certificate or a valid tax pin.

4.2 **A certificate certifying that the bidder has no undisputed commitments for Municipal services towards a municipality or service provider i.r.o. payments which are overdue more than 90 days; if the bidder is the lessee a valid lease agreement together with the municipal account of the landlord; or a letter from tribal authority if the service provider operates in rural area.**

4.3 **1 EP Minimum CIDB grading is required for this project.**

4.4 MBD 4, 6.1, 8 and 9 must be fully completed and submitted together with a quotation.

4.5 Bidders must be registered on the Central Supplier Data Base.

4.6 The tender will be evaluated in terms of the 80/20 preference points system of which 80 points will be for price and 20 points for specific goals (Locality and HDI) as illustrated below
